

Day 1: Tuesday 27 July 2021 – Brisbane to Longreach (B,L,D)

Board the Spirit of the Outback at Roma Street Station for your overnight Rail Journey to Longreach.

Day 2: Wednesday 28 July 2021 – Longreach (B,L,D)

Arrive in Longreach for the start of your Outback Queensland adventure. You will be met Longreach Railway Station by your Savannah Guide Operator Driver and transferred to your accommodation at Saltbush Retreat. Meet fellow travellers for a tour briefing and Welcome Supper before retiring to our accommodation for the next three nights.

Hotel: Saltbush Retreat, Longreach – 3 nights' accommodation

Day 3: Thursday 29 July 2021 – Longreach (B,L,D)

Join our Strathmore Station Tour for an insider's view into life on the land followed by a delicious home-baked morning tea. Explore the five themed galleries of the Australian Stockman's Hall of Fame then take your seat for the entertaining Outback Stockman's Show. Late afternoon experience the warm hospitality of local graziers with a visit to Camden Park Station. Enjoy a personalised tour of the property, family homestead and sunset drinks.

Day 4: Friday 30 July 2021 – Longreach (B,L,D)

Witness a totally different way of schooling on a tour of the Longreach School of Distance Education. Visit historic Rosebank Station originally settled as a sheep and cattle station some 100 years ago. Visit the world-class Qantas Founders Museum, eloquently telling the story of the founding of Qantas. View marvellous interpretive and interactive exhibits then join a guided Jets Tour. Late afternoon unwind on the Drover's Sunset Cruise with tasty on-board nibbles platters followed by a two-course table service dinner under the stars at Smithy's Outback Dinner & Show.

Day 5: Saturday 31 July 2021 - Winton (B,L,D)

Travel west to Winton and learn the story behind Australia's unofficial national anthem at the Waltzing Matilda Centre; the only museum dedicated to a song. Discover the quirky Arno's Wall and play a tune on what is believed to be the world's only musical fence. Check-in to your accommodation for the next two nights then enjoy some free time in downtown Winton. This afternoon, we take a short drive out of town to the Australian Age of Dinosaurs, perched high on a spectacular mesa. Join a guided interpretive tour of the laboratory, collection room and Dinosaur Canyon. Take in the moment at our incredibly special sunset barbeque overlooking the plains where dinosaurs once roamed!

Hotel: Boulder Opal Motor Inn, Winton – 2 nights' accommodation

Day 6: Sunday 01 August 2021 - Winton (B,L,D)

Travel into the heart of Waltzing Matilda country and drive along private tracks to the beautiful Carisbrooke Station. Here we will follow the scenic Cory's Range drive to the Three Sisters rock formation, fossick for opals and enjoy a relaxed billy tea. Witness a prehistoric event from some 95 million years ago at Dinosaur Stampede, Lark Quarry Conservation Park. Join an interpretive tour of the world's only recorded dinosaur stampede featuring over 3000 footprints frozen in time in ancient mudflats. Return to Winton for a relaxed dinner at your accommodation tonight.

Day 7: Monday 02 August 2021 – Longreach - Brisbane (B)

Following an early breakfast, we end the tour with a short drive back to Longreach to join our afternoon return flight back to Brisbane.
