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Day 1 – Saturday 5 June 2027	Depart Brisbane – Arrive Norfolk / Welcome Dinner at Hotel	[D]
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Welcome to the start of your holiday on beautiful Norfolk Island. This morning you meet at the Brisbane International Airport for your flight to Norfolk Island with Qantas. Departing Brisbane on QF183 at 09:35am, arriving beautiful Norfolk Island at 12:45pm local time. Upon arrival one of the experienced staff from Pinetree Tours will meet you at Norfolk Island Airport and transfer you to our home for the next 7 nights, Aloha Apartments, in Deluxe One-Bedroom Apartments. Day 2 – Sunday 6 June 2027	Half Day Island Tour / Convict Settlement Tour	[B, D]
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Pinetree Tours Half Day Island Tour is a must for every visitor! It is one of the most comprehensive day tours on Norfolk Island. On this tour, you are taken to some of the key historic areas, including Kingston, Cascade and Longridge. This is your chance to learn all about the fascinating history of Norfolk Island. See the famous convict buildings for yourself and enjoy the stories told in the full commentary as you visit each new place. Take in the amazing views from the lookouts, where you'll get to enjoy our beautiful beaches in all their glory. Learn about Norfolk Island government, laws and of course, their unique lifestyle. Morning tea is included. Lunch today is own arrangements. Then this afternoon we join Pinetree Tours on this 'in depth' tour of the historic Georgian settlement of Kingston. Walk through the cemetery and hear the history of interesting convict & colonial headstones, hear stories of the houses along Quality Row. Walk through the ruins of the New Gaol, see the Pier Store, Boat Shed and the Crank Mill. Afternoon tea is included. After time to freshen up, we enjoy dinner at the Bounty Bar & Grill this evening.

Day 3 – Monday 7 June 2027	Cyclorama / Glass Bottom Boat / Dinner at Hilli's	[B, L, D]
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Today visit Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama, an unforgettable experience. An outstanding attraction and Tourism Awards winner, this stunning 360 panoramic painting has been impressing visitors with its 'wow' factor for over 10 years. Walk inside the circular painting and be surrounded by the immense artwork that traces the history of the Bounty leaving England through Tahiti, Pitcairn Island and arrival at Norfolk Island in 1856. A local Norfolk Islander, Donald will share his knowledge of Norfolk's unique marine life. Once you've 'walked the plank' with these 'mutineer descendants' it takes 60 seconds to be at the reef. View beautiful coral gardens and tropical fish inside the calm crystal waters of Norfolk's lagoon. Donald will provide full and interesting commentary on the environmental tour. You should be prepared for a touch of Norfolk humour. This evening dinner is at a local favourite, Hilli.

Day 4 – Tuesday 8 June 2027	Bounty Picnic Day Celebrations / Dinner at Paradise Resort	[B, D]
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Today marks one of the most celebrated and popular calendar of events on Norfolk Island. Bounty Day marks the anniversary of the arrival of Pitcairn Islanders to Norfolk Island. You will enjoy a day of festivities with the locals. We will have dinner this evening at Paradise Hotel & Resort.

Day 5 – Wednesday 9 June 2027	Breakfast Bush Walk / Progressive Dinner	[B, D]
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Take your choice of an easy stroll through 100 acres reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of both walks we meet on the cliff top for a delicious BBQ Breakfast. (People not wishing to do a walk, will be able to join the group for the scenic cliff top breakfast). Tonight, enjoy a 3-course meal progressing to different Norfolk Island family homes. A fun night and a great way to meet the local people and sample some of the Island dishes.

Day 6 – Thursday 10 June 2027	Colleen McCullough Home / Island Fish Fry / Sound & Light Show	[B, D]
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Colleen McCullough, world renowned author of 24 books called Norfolk Island home for almost 36 years. Sadly, Colleen passed away in 2015 after a long battle with illness. Her beloved property "Out Yenna" is now open for a tour. You are escorted through her magnificent home and are able to view Ric and Colleen's priceless collection of artifacts gathered on their travels all over the world. You will see where her books were researched, and where Norfolk Island pies were made from local eggs and fruit in season. This is a glimpse into the life of a modern-day literary icon. Late this afternoon watch the sun set from a stunning Cliff Top setting at 'Orn daa Cliff' on Norfolk's beautiful western coastline and enjoy a feast of local Island dishes, salads, homemade bread and fresh fried fish, followed by an Island dessert and tea or coffee. While you dine in paradise, you are treated to some local entertainment. Nightfall at Kingston brings a different mood to the convict settlement. The stillness and the stars are just as they were before mankind arrived in 1788. However, with the dramatic use of real-life sound together with theatrical lighting and costumed actors, the stillness is broken as Pinetree Tours takes you through the horrifying decades of Norfolk Island's convict era.

Day 7 – Friday 11 June 2027	Bounty Folk Museum / Pizza Night	[B, D]
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The Bounty Folk Museum is a hands-on, heart-filled portal into Norfolk Island's layered past. Tucked within its unassuming walls lies a surprising treasure trove: rooms brimming with curios, convict relics, Pitcairn family heirlooms and everyday tools that once shaped extraordinary lives. Rest of day at leisure. Friday night is Pizza night at Castaway Norfolk Island, so we will enjoy delicious wood-fired pizzas for dinner this evening.

Day 8 – Saturday 12 June 2027	Depart Norfolk – Arrive Brisbane	[B]
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This morning you may wish to visit the local markets, which is just next to your accommodation. The local markets at Rawson's Hill, is a great opportunity to purchase some arts and crafts, see all the local produce on offer. Later, we bid farewell to our new friends at Aloha Apartments, and we are transferred to the Norfolk Island Airport for our return flight to Brisbane, departing Norfolk Island on QF184 at 1:45pm and arriving into Brisbane at 3:15pm. Collect your bags and clear customs, before making your way home. We hope you have enjoyed your time on our island paradise. (Flight times subject to change).
